

THAI VISA APPLICATION FOR NON-THAI NATIONALS

NON-IMMIGRANT VISA- “ED PLUS”

(Education for Bachelor degree and above only)

Single Entry | 3 Months

Issued to international students currently studying at universities/institutions in Thailand at a bachelor’s degree level or above. During the course of study, Non-ED PLUS Visa holders can depart and re-enter Thailand without the need for a re-entry permit. After receiving NON-ED PLUS, Universities/institutions will submit the visa extension application on behalf of the students.

NON-ED Plus Visa allows holder to extend their stay in Thailand for 1 year after graduation, to seek employment, travel or take part in other activities, and are eligible to change the type of visa in Thailand if employed.

Visa will be valid for one entry within 90 days from the date of visa issuance

CHECKLIST

- An application form completely filled out and signed by the applicant;
- Visa request letter from the applicant mentioning the purpose;
- A valid passport for travelling to Thailand with sufficient remaining validity (not less than six month);
- One set of passport information page photocopy, last Thai visa page & renewal page (if any);
- Two colour passport-sized photos (3.5 x 4.5cm), taken against white background and within the past 6 months;
- Evidence of adequate finance e.g. Current Bank Solvency and Bank Statement of the last 6 months with satisfactory transaction (*at least 20,000 Baht per person and 40,000 Baht per family OR 60,000 Taka per person and 120,000 Taka per family*). Only original Bank Statement and Bank Solvency Letter are acceptable. In case where the applicant is sponsored by his/her company and the company Bank Statement and Bank Solvency Letter are submitted, a trade license has to be attached;

- Letter from Thai university/institution;
- Letter confirming enrollment details from Thai university/institution, signed by authorized person together with a copy of ID card/passport of the signer.
- A copy of air ticket, a booking confirmation, or an itinerary.

NOTE:

- Short descriptions in English shall be provided for all Thai documents;
- For documents in other foreign languages (including Bangla) must be translated into English and shall be certified by a credible translator and a notary public.
