(Education, Work visits and training) Single Entry | Multiple Entry (1 Year)

(Application for one-year Non-Immigrant Visa "ED" is required prior approval from the Royal Thai Embassy before submission of visa fee)

CHECKLIST

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- □ An application form completely filled out and signed by the applicant (signature must match with the signature in the current passport);
- □ A valid passport for travelling to Thailand with sufficient remaining validity (not less than six months). The validity of 18 months is required for one-year visa application;
- \Box A photocopy of the last Thai visa page (if any);
- \Box 1 colour passport-sized photos (3.5 x 4.5cm), taken against a white background and within the past 6 months;
- Evidence of adequate finance e.g. current bank solvency and bank statement of the last 6 months with satisfactory transaction (*at least 20,000 Baht per person and 40,000 Baht per family or 60,000 Taka per person and 120,000 Taka per family*). Only original bank statement and bank solvency letter are acceptable. In case the applicant is sponsored by his/her company, the company's trade license, the company's bank statement and bank solvency letter must be submitted;
- □ A copy of air ticket or a booking confirmation or an itinerary;
- □ <u>Only for those who wishes to apply with business documents for work visits or</u> <u>training with governmental agencies/state enterprise/international organizations</u>:
 - Original trade license in Bengali and a photocopy of notarized English translation;
 - Memorandum and Articles of Association for limited company if the applicant's name not mentioned in trade license.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- □ Visa request letter from self *or* from office indicating the purpose of visit
- \Box Applicant's ID card;
- □ Invitation Letter and Acceptance Letter from school, university, institution in Thailand signed by concerned authority;
- □ Latest educational certificate certified by the MOFA;
- Only for Foreign Monk who wishes to pursue a study in religious field with Thai religious institution: Letter of approval from the Office of the National Buddhism and authorization from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.

NOTE:

Documents in languages other than English *(including Bangla)* must be translated into English and shall be certified by a credible translator and a notary public.
